

Williams discusses 14th Amendment at event



Seventh U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals Judge Ann Claire Williams addressed an audience at The John Marshall Law School on Tuesday during a discussion on the U.S. Constitution's 14th Amendment and its implementation. Williams spoke at a program that marked the presentation of the exhibit *Marching Toward Justice*, which follows black history from slavery through the Civil Rights Movement.
